

New IU VC sacks pro-VC

ISLAMIC University pro-vice-chancellor M Kamaluddin was removed from his post on Tuesday in the face of a two-month movement of students and teachers against him and two other IU top hats over allegations of irregularities in appointing faculty members.

The movement was launched in November in protest against what the teachers and students termed 'recruitment trade' run by the then VC, the just-fired pro-VC, and the treasurer.

The relentless and acute agitation finally forced the government to replace Prof M Alauddin with Prof Abdul Hakim Sarkar of Dhaka University as the IU VC. And, promptly after taking over as the VC on Tuesday, A Hakim announced that the pro-VC was sacked.
