

ASSAULT ON JU TEACHER
**Decision not to suspend
BCL leader protested**

Pro-BNP teachers of Jahangirnagar University yesterday protested the decision of the university authorities to give only a warning to a student instead of suspending him for allegedly assaulting a teacher.

The university authorities in a syndicate meeting on Wednesday has decided to give a warning to Rajib Ahmed Rasel, general secretary of BCL, JU unit for allegedly assaulting lecturer Nurul Haque on April 6.

Rajib received a warning of three-month long suspension if he creates any anarchy on the campus.

The teachers, along with Nurul, laid siege to the vice chancellor's office after they were informed of the decision.

Prof Sayed Kamrul Ahsan, dean of arts and humanity faculty, said, "The university authorities are mocking us, as earlier the VC said he would suspend Rajib but did not do so."
