1,000 primary head teachers to be appointed soon

State Minister for Education Principal Mohammad Eunus Khan on Friday said steps would be taken soon to fill up vacancies of 1,000 head teachers of the primary schools, reports BSS.

He said the present government would solve the problems of the primary school teachers through negotiation and discussions.
