Mothers rally demands compulsory primary education

BOGRA, Oct. 27.—A mammoth gathering of 'MA' (mothers) organised to back the demand for the implementation of compulsory primary education and Health Programme was held at Malinagar Government Primary School in Bogra Town recently. Different speakers spoke on the importance of compulsory primary education.

Presided over by Mr. Tozammel Haque Khan, the meeting was addressed among others, by Deputy Director Abdul Hamid (Retd) Rajshahi, TNO Tarapada Paul and Education Officer Abdus Sattar.

The boy was suspected to have been killed by stragulation. Some injuries were also found on the body.

Bogra Zilla Parishad will implement 18 projects at a cost of Taka 36.00 lac under Development programme during the current fiscal year in Bogra, this was officially disclosed.

The programmes include three passengers' shades, development of Shariakandi Dak-Banglo, repairing of roads and supplying of benches in primary schools.

The work of the programmes are expected to begin from the next month.
