

## JSTU students begin exams boycott

STUDENTS of Jessore Science and Technology University on Saturday began boycotting semester final examinations protesting against increase in fees.

University assistant registrar Mohamimad Emdadul Haque said that the authority suspended all examinations till Monday in the face of the protests of the students.

The opening of classes in master's courses was also suspended, he said.

A meeting of the regent board of the university will be held on Monday to discuss the issue, he added.

Vice-chancellor Abdus Sattar said that there were politics behind the protests.

Earlier, on May 21, the students confined the vice-chancellor, teachers and officials inside their offices till for about eight hours protesting against the increase in admission fees and other charges.
