

## BCL men go berserk after leader refused job at RU

ACTIVISTS of Bangladesh Chhatra League on Saturday rampaged through Rajshahi University administrative building after one of their leaders failed to qualify for a job at the university.

Witnesses said that about 20-25 activists of BCL, local Awami League and Juba League led by the university unit BCL vice-president Masud Rana locked the administrative building at around 8:00am after coming to know that Masud was not selected for the job.

They vandalised the offices of deputy registrar Abdul Majid and Mozaffar Hossain, secretary to the

pro-vice-chancellor, and assaulted two officers.

They damaged furniture and smashed windowpanes of the offices.

BCL sources said that Masud had applied for the post of an officer in the university administration but the last syndicate meeting on Wednesday did not select him.

When contacted, Masud denied there was any such incident.

RU proctor Chowdhury Muhammad Zakaria told newsmen that steps against the attackers would be taken after discussion with vice-chancellor M Abdus Sobhan.

The VC could not be reached for comments.
