**BCL men try to enter SBMC hostel again**

GIRL students of Sher-Bangla Medical College in Barsingha on Tuesday boycotted classes and held a press conference on the campus seeking their safety and security and punishment of Chhatra League people who entered the girls' hostel on Sunday night and attacked it on Monday night.

A group of Chhatra League people led by Maniraj and Hanin cordoned off the hostel and tried to enter it.

## BCL men try to enter SBMC hostel

BCL activists protested at the hostel and demanded that they boycott classes for lack of safety and security. The hostel residents also demanded resignation of the hostel superintendent SM Sarwar and removal of BCL activist Nupur Pal from the position of the hostel's secretary. They also demanded the appointment of the superintendent through election by the residents. Their other demands include the appointment of a female superintendent, additional guards police patrol and the election of a committee for the hostel management.

The mayor asked the college authorities to hold a fair investigation of the incident. The principal said that they had set up a six-member committee, headed by the day.

Law enforcers, who were informed of the matter by journalists, reached the place and tried to disperse the Chhatra League people. Chhatra League activists then stopped trying to break in but kept cordoning off the hostel. They also pelted the hostel with stones and started abusing the residents. The principal and some teachers later went there. sent away BCL men, and assured the girls of safety and security after midnight past the day.

about 9:30pm Monday break in with hockey sticks with residents rallied inside the hostel and sought help from journalists over mobile. Law enforcers, who were informed of the matter by journalists, reached the place and tried to disperse the Chhatra League people. Chhatra League activists then stopped trying to break in but kept cordoning off the hostel. They also pelted the hostel with stones and started abusing the residents.
