

10 BUET students sent to jail

By A. METROPOLITAN magistrates' court on Sunday sent to jail 10 students of Bangladesh University of Engineering and Technology on commission of their interrogation in police custody.

A Metropolitan magistrate Augur Rahman passed the order rejecting their petition seeking bail.

The police on June 13 raided Star Hotel and Restaurant at Tharabazar in the city and picked up 22 people, mostly students of BUET and other private universities on charge of their suspicious movement.

The War police later released all but the 10 of the detainees after obtaining undertakings, the police said.

The War police suspected that the 10 students were conspiring at the restaurant for some subversive activities.

On June 14, the court remanded them in police custody for a day for interrogation.

On Sunday, the defence counsel filed petition seeking bail for the 10 students saying that the students were supposed to take examination today. They should be remanded on bail as the police found no evidence of criminal charges against them.

In reply, the police said that they found important information from the arrested and the students should be detained in jail for the sake of proper investigation.
