

Sylhet college principal sues BCL leader

Principal of Madan Mohan College in Sylhet city Abul Foteh Fattah sued the college unit Bangladesh Chhatra League President Arun Devnath Sagar and 15 activists on Wednesday night for vandalising his office and demanding money from the institution's fund illegally.

In the case filed with Kotwali Police Station, the complainant said that on Sunday afternoon, Sagar demanded money from the college fund in the name of organising the upcoming Saraswati puja.

As Fattah said he could not do that without the formation of a puja committee and the approval of the college managing committee, Sagar broke into fury and damaged several chairs, windows in his office and hurled abuses at some teachers, he added.

Talking to The Daily Star, the principal alleged that Sagar's group had been involved in extorting money from admission seekers and other misdeeds at the college in the last few years. The BCL leader could not be reached for comments.
