

BCL expels 7 over factional clash at DU

Bangladesh Chhatra League (BCL) last night expelled seven leaders and activists of its Mukujoddha Ziaur Rahman Hall unit of Dhaka University over a factional clash.

An emergency meeting of the student body's central unit made the decision against the BCL men for their involvement in an "unexpected" incident at the dormitory, said a press release.

The expelled are hall unit BCL vice-president Saddam, joint general secretary Gazi Hasib, organising secretary Hashu and activists Sohag, Riad, Opu and Asad.

The meeting also asked hall unit president Abu Salman Prodhan Shaon and general secretary Motahar Hossain Prince to explain by Sunday why organisational action against them would not be taken.

On Wednesday, two factions of the BCL's hall unit locked into a clash over stealing shoes, leaving at least two injured.

Yesterday, supporters of the BCL unit president and secretary clashed at the Madhur Canteen on the campus.
