

DU POLITICAL SCIENCE DEPARTMENT Students burn mark sheet photocopies

Re-evaluation of answer sheets demanded

A group of students of political science department of Dhaka University yesterday burnt photocopies of their mark sheets on the campus, demanding re-evaluation of the answer sheets of master's first semester examination.

The agitated students of section B (session: 2008-09) demonstrated in front of the department's chairperson's office, alleging "discrimination" against them in the result system.

The result was published on March 10. A total of 84 students out of 98 of section A of the same batch achieved GPA 3.50, while only 28 out of 133 students of B section secured GPA 3.50, said the protesting students.

On the other hand, a total of five students achieved highest GPA 3.94 and three others GPA 3.88 - all belonging to section A.

The protesters said although they had met vice-chancellor and dean of social sciences, no action was yet to be taken in this regard.

Prof Nurul Amin Bepari, chairperson of the department, said they would hold an emergency meeting on the issue today to come up with a solution.
