

## JU VC again declares to quit

Vice-Chancellor of Jahangirnagar University Prof Anwar Hossain yesterday announced for the second time that he would soon resign.

Talking to The Daily Star, at his temporary office and residence, the VC said he had decided to submit his resignation letter to Chancellor Abdúl Hamid soon. "I have already sent an application to the chancellor requesting to meet with him," he added.

VC made his first announcement of his resignation during a press conference at JU senate hall but later he backtracked on his decision saying "students want him back at JU". The university has been facing chaos for almost a year centering the VC's resignation.

On December 5, a team of police escorted Prof Anwar out of the campus, upon directives from the government high-ups, in the face of relentless protests by teachers-students.

Later, Prof Anwar had rented a house in the capital's Uttara and declared it as his temporary office.
