Says Nahid at convocation of East West University

Education Minister Nurul Islam Nahid yesterday warned that tough action would be taken against the private universities failing to build their own campuses within the stipulated time and meet the prescribed standards.

Addressing the 13th convocation of East West University in the capital's Aftabnagar, he recommended that other private universities follow the example of EWU in this regard.

This year 1,341 students, including four gold medal winners, were awarded certificates. The education minister presided over the graduation ceremony as the representative of the president. In his speech, he praised the role of private universities in imparting higher education, according to a press release.
