## 20 students of Sylhet Polytechnic Instt injured in clashes with police, workers

SYLHET, Nov 18:—Twenty students of Sylhet Polytechnic Institute were injured in a series of clashes with construction workers and police Sunday, reports UNB.

Witnesses said the trouble ensued when a guard of an under-construction railway station near the institute dragged a student into the construction site and beat him up following an altercation with him.

Later, a group of 25 students came to the construction site and locked in a clash with the workers, leaving 11 students injured.

Angered by the attacks, over a hundred students later rushed to the spot in a procession and clashed with police as they did not allow them to enter the construction site.

Nine students were injured as police charged baton and lobbed teargas shells to disperse them.

Police arrested three students and two construction workers from the scene.

Three of the injured were admitted to Sylhet Osmani Medical Hospital in critical conditions while four others to a private clinic.
