300 answer scripts seized, one arrested

CHITTAGONG, Apr 10—At least three hundred answer scripts of Mathematics of the last Secondary School Certificate (SSC) examination held under Chittagong Education Board were recovered from bath room of Bahaddarhat inter-district bus terminal today by Chandgaon police, a CMP Press release said, reports BSS.

Acting on a tip-off, a taskforce of the Chandgaon police arrested Nizam alias Badiul Alam, 35, son of late Md Ali of Lohagara in the district and on the basis of his statement the scripts contained in a gunny bag were recovered.

The scripts were stolen from a Cox's Bazar bound bus at Bahaddarhat bus terminal on Monday while Salah Ahmed, the examiner and headmaster of the Rajakali Fajjunnesa High School under Chakoria thana in Cox's Bazar district went to the ticket counter keeping the answer scripts in the bus.

Investigation is continuing to bring the other culprits to book and a case was lodged with Chandgaon Police in this regard.
