

## Poetry book depicting Khaleda's struggle

The long nine years uncompromising struggle of Begum Khaleda Zia, who became the Prime Minister of Bangladesh as a symbol of people's hopes and aspiration, greatly stirred the country's literary arena, reports BSS.

Twenty-two patriotic poets, being inspired by her sense of patriotism, commitment to the nation and deep respect to democracy, compiled a book of poems under the title "Jey Agun Chhariay Diley", a Press release of the organisers said in Dhaka.

The 48-page book of poems with four colours offset print will be available at the inaugural function of the fourth national council session of BNP beginning on September 1, at Manik Mia Avenue in Dhaka.
