

## Students urged to fight against terrorism: PM

Prime Minister Begum Khaleda Zia on Friday called upon the student community to fight unitedly against terrorism to bring smile into the faces of their parents, reports BSS.

Addressing a function in celebration of the 14th Founding Anniversary of Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal (JCD) at the Institution of Engineers in Dhaka on Friday evening Begum Zia said acts of violence could not deliver the good to the nation.
