Tough action against campus violence: PM

Prime Minister Begum Khaleda Zia termed the recent violences on the campuses as planned conspiracy and warned that stringent actions would be taken against those resorting to anarchy and indiscipline to destroy the academic atmosphere, reports BSS.

Addressing the members of Dhaka College and Tejgaon College students Sangsad at her Suganda office Begum Zia said the non students or outsiders were creating anarchy on the campuses as a part of a planned conspiracy at home and abroad to undermine the glorious role of students.

The Prime Minister said the conspiracy was hatched when the academic atmosphere has returned in the educational institutions and brain drain has been stopped.

"We want that all the educational institutions should function smoothly
