PM's call to observe Oct 5 as World Teachers Day officially

Leaders of Bangladesh Federation of Teachers' Association (BFTA) on Friday called upon Prime Minister Begum Khaleda Zia to observe October 5 as 'World Teachers Day' officially, reports BSS.

They said in a statement that the World Teachers Day was first observed in the country in 1995 at the directive of Prime Minister Khaleda Zia.

The BFTA leaders urged the Prime Minister to direct the authorities concerned to chalk out programmes to observe the day nationally.

They also invited the Prime Minister to inaugurate the World Teachers Day programme on October 5.
