



Govt pledge-bound to ensure quality education for all: PM

Prime Minister Begum Khaleda Zia on Friday said the government is pledge bound to discharge constitutional obligation to ensure quality education for all, reports BSS.

"We have taken firm measures to promote primary schooling considering its importance of education and demand of society," she said in a message to mark National Primary Education Week.

The Prime Minister said that her government had taken various measures for expansion of primary education maintaining its quality.

"We have decided to provide primary education free of cost in all government and non-government primary schools along with Taka 100 as stipend for meritorious and poor students," she said.
