



Popularise IT edn, President tells varsity team

A 12-member delegation of the Association of Universities of Bangladesh, led by Dhaka University Vice-Chancellor Prof. Anwarullah Chowdhury, called on President Prof. AQM Badruddoza Chowdhury at Bangabhaban in Dhaka on Saturday, reports BSS.

The members of the delegation discussed with the President about the academic atmosphere in different universities.

President Prof. Chowdhury said that university authorities should develop teacher-student relation-

ship and initiate holding of parents or guardians-teachers meeting frequently to ensure congenial academic atmosphere in the highest seats of learning in the country.

The President said that the students should be given ample opportunity to flourish their cultural talents, and their literary activities should be rewarded.

Vice-Chancellors of Rajshahi University, Bangladesh Agricultural University, Bangladesh Engineering University, Chittagong University, Islamic University, Shahjalal Science and Technology University, Khulna University, National University, Bangladesh Open University and Bangabandhu Sheikh Mujibur Rahman Agricultural University were present at the meeting.

A five-member delegation of the Bangladesh Teachers Association, led by its Secretary General Selim Bhuiyan also called the President on Saturday.

The President advised them to popularise IT education in schools and give importance on the English education along with Bengali.
