



Family life education project taken

The government has taken a project to educate adolescents and adults in family life through non-formal education programme, official sources said on Friday, reports BSS.

They said the Family Life Education Project had been adopted with financial assistance from the United Nations Population Fund.

Primary and Mass Education Directorate sources said 5,577 teachers, 5,139 supervisors and 418 officials and employees of different tiers were trained in the last one year for the project.

They said 22 supplementary reading materials were developed and printed through different workshops for this purpose.

Besides, a number of topics on family life education have been included in the non-formal education programme materials.
