

Literacy rate rises by 12 pc in 4 yrs: Khaleda

BOGRA, Sept. 26: Prime Minister Begum Khaleda Zia today called upon the affluent section of the society to come forward in expanding the education, reports BSS.

She said the participation of the affluent in the expansion of education would help imparting education to the vast section of the population more easily.

The Prime Minister was addressing a ceremony awarding "Shaheed Ziaur Rahman Memorial Scholarship" at the Vocational Teachers' Training Institute auditorium.

Begum Zia said, "We have to come forward to complete the unfinished task of Shaheed President Ziaur Rahman by carrying ahead the cause of education."

The Prime Minister distributed the scholarship for 1995 comprising cash, certificates and crests among 50 students who became successful in the HSC examination of 1994 in 16 districts.
