Bangabandhu Medical varsity team calls on PM

A delegation of Bangabandhu Sheikh Mujib Medical University comprising its Vice Chancellor Prof M.A Quadri and Syndicate members called on Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina at her office Monday afternoon, reports BSS.

Prof Quadri expressed his gratitude and thanks for setting up of the university after the Name of Bangabandhu Sheikh Mujibur Rahman to impart medical education and provide medical facilities.

He referred to certain demands including land for extension of the university and also ensure additional fund.

The Prime Minister said the Government has decided that the land adjacent to the medical university earmarked for the construction of a five-star hotel would be handed over to the university and alternate land would be allotted for the hotel. She called for making a green belt around the Medical University while taking up the construction work. She also stressed for setting up of a modern casualty department. She said the cabin should be more attractive and service-oriented.

The Prime Minister suggested that doctors may allowed to do private practice in the hospitals for which
