

Rly links resume

BAU students withdraw barricade

MYMENSINGH, Sept 5:-Rail communications on Dhaka-Mymensingh-Jamalpur route resumed Tuesday as the agitating students of the veterinary department of Mymensingh Agriculture University withdrew their barricade following assurance of the Vice-Chancellor to meet their demands, reports BD News.

Some 200 to 300 students of the veterinary department of the university blocked the rail routes at Mymensingh station at 10:30 am to press home their demand of keeping 20 percent attachment to the Livestock Breeding and Management courses.

Witnesses said that the agitating students had also kept stranded the Mahua Express coming from Dhaka at Mymensingh Railway Station Tuesday morning.

The students also created barricade on the railroads putting logs (See page 15 Col. 3)

and setting fire there to suspend Dhaka-Mymensingh-Jamalpur rail communications.

As a result, two Mymensingh-bound trains - Padma and Baleka Express- got stranded at another station near Mymensingh.

The students agreed to withdraw their movement following assurance from Mosharraf Hossain Mia, newly appointed VC of the university, of accepting all their demands.

Classes, examinations and academic activities of the veterinary department of the university remained postponed since August 23.
