JCD attacks BCL at Dhaka College, 10 hurt

At least 10 activists of Bangladesh Chhatra League (BCL) were injured in a attack by the cadres of Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal (JCD) at Dhaka College in the city on Sunday.

The JCD cadres blasted bombs and opened fire on the BCL activists creating panic among the general students.

Following the JCD attack, the BCL activists damaged some eight minibuses and private cars in front of the college.

According to sources, some 50 BCL activists went to Dhaka College and gathered in the college premises on Sunday morning. At one stage the JCD cadres attacked the BCL activists leaving ten BCL men injured. JCD cadres blasted six bombs and opened fire during the attack. They chased the BCL activists and drove them out of the campus.

In the face of JCD attack, the BCL men come out of the campus and gathered on Mirpar-Newmarket road. The agitated BCL activists damaged some passing vehicles at that time.

Police arrested Bipul Kumar Singho, joint secretary of BCL, Dhaka College unit in connection of the vehicle-damaging incident.

A tense situation has been prevailing on the Dhaka College campus following the incident and a huge number of police was deployed to prevent further clash.
