Sexual harassment of female students

Students threaten greater movement on JU failure

SAVAR, Dec 20:—The probe body, formed to investigate into allegation of sexual harassment of several female students of Bangla Department by a teacher of the department, submitted report to the university authority on Wednesday. The university authorities have in an emergency syndicate meeting on Thursday took measures against the accused teacher.

The agitating students on Wednesday gheraoed the administrative building for more than three hours and submitted a memorandum to JU Vice-Chancellor demanding immediate

removal of the alleged teacher. The angry students brought out a procession on the campus. Later they burnt the effigy of accused teacher Dr. Golam Mostafa.

A female student of Bangla Department in an allegation to JU said that a teacher of the department Dr. Mostafa sexually harassed her. Later nine students of the department lodged allegation against the same teacher. The agitating students vowed to intensify the movement to dislodge the accused teacher if the authorities failed to meet their demand by December 23. They also threatened to stop academic activities of the university.
