

900 JU students to miss 3rd convocation due to session jam

Due to session jam about 950 students of Jahangirnagar University would not be able to participate in the 3rd convocation of the university. These students of 2003 honours batch of 15 various departments along with 2002 masters batch of 16 departments have become the victim of session jam, reports BDNews.

Jahangirnagar University has 28 departments including 4 new departments opened only this year. Urban and Regional Planning department was opened in

the 1998-99 academic session, but no student of this department would be able to join the convocation due to the session jam in JU's academic calendar.

Graduates of 1998 to 2003 and post-graduates of 1998 to 2002 academic year and students who have completed their M.Phil or PhD courses will also be awarded their certificates on the convocation.

The 950 students have already completed their final exams but due to the delay by the authorities to publish their results they are deprived of their joy to join the convocation. Some students of even earlier sessions are also caught in the same trap of session jam.

Being unable to take part in the convocation Md. Baki Billah, a student of Zoology department of the university in his utter distress has accused the teachers of their negligence and the endless session jam for the present situation.
