

# What's wrong with LLB exam centre, Manikganj?

MANIKGANJ: Should the LLB examination centre at Manikganj be continued? The Government Devendra College which conducts the centre at its premises recently wrote to Dhaka University for cancellation of the centre alleging adoption of unfair means by candidates.

The principal of the law col-

lege at Manikganj, however, denied the charges and instead made accusations against the Government Devendra College management.

The principal of the Khondoker Nurul Hossain Law Academy at Manikganj in a statement to the Press alleged that a certain group was trying to cancel the LLB examination centre at Manikganj and destroy the image of the law college established in 1972.

Advocate Khondoker Delwar Hossain, principal of the law academy said that 100 LLB candidates from his law college appeared at the Government Devendra College centre in this session's examinations which were held peacefully. Dr. Kamal aruddin, dean of the faculty of law of Dhaka University and Mr. Amin Mia Chowdhury, commissioner of Dhaka division inspected the examination centre at Manikganj Government Devendra College on October 1. The principal of Government Devendra College, who also holds the charge of the centre, and the deputy commissioner of Manikganj informed the inspection team headed by the dean that the examinations were held peacefully.

In his statement, the principal of the law college blamed the management of the examination centre for realisation cen-

tre fees at higher than university prescribed rates. He said that the Devendra College authority realised Taka 175 to Taka 375.00 from each of the candidates of preliminary and final examinations respectively. The university's fixed rate was Taka 50 for each candidate. The candidates had earlier protested against this.

When asked, the principal of the Government Devendra College said that he wrote to Dhaka University for cancellation of the LLB examination centre at Manikganj on the basis of allegations made by some teachers.
