



AL supports BCL's strike call

A meeting of Presidium of Awami League on Sunday lent its support to the countrywide dawn-to-dusk hartal tomorrow (Tuesday) called by Bangladesh Chhatra League.

Bangladesh Chhatra League, the front organisation of Awami League called the countrywide hartal in protest against police raid on Shamsunnahar Hall of Dhaka University and attack on female students.

Presided over by acting President of Awami League Abdus Samad Azad, the Presidium meeting protested against the police raid on Shamsunnahar Hall and attack on students by police.
