

## Seminar speakers for Opposing ban-move on students politics

CHITTAGONG, July 28:— Speakers at a seminar on Friday evening urged the conscious students to stand against the move to restrict student-politics in the university campus.

Chittagong District unit of Bangladesh Chhatra Union (BCU) organized the seminar titled "Golden Jubilee of Bangladesh Chhatra Union: Mainstream student politics in Bangladesh" at Zilla Parishad Auditorium.

Saran Barua, a senior worker of Bangladesh Chhatra Union (BCU), presented the keynote paper. President of Chittagong District unit of BCU Mohammad Shah Alam presided over the session.

The seminar was addressed among others by founder President of BCU of Chittagong Unit Abdullah Al Harun Chowdhury, former central President of BCU and DUCSU Vice-President Mu-

jahidul Islam Selim, former DUCSU Vice-President Mahfuja Khanam, former President of Chittagong Unit of BCU Abu Taher Masud.

Former Central President of BCU and DUCSU Vice-President Mujahidul Islam Selim in his speech said that the organization had been facing problems due to unpredicted polarization in the geo-politics.
