

CUOA observes 4-hr strike

CHITTAGONG, Oct 06: Members of the Chittagong University Officers Association (CUOA) abstained from their routine work for about 4 hours on Sunday.

They went on the work abstention asking the university to accept their 5-point demands. The demands include restoration of departmental promotion and enhancement of their retirement age up to 65 years.

During their work abstention the members of CUOA arranged a rally in front of the administrative building of the university. Presided over by the Kazi Mohammad Jalauddin the rally was also addressed among others Jaker Ahmed and Manoranjan Das.

In the rally the speakers of CUOA threatened that if the university authorities were not met within October 21 they will observe another 72-hour of work abstention from October 22.
