



Judicial body on SN hall incident starts work

The Judicial Inquiry Commission formed to probe the police atrocities at Dhaka University's Shamsunnahar Hall and arrest of female students started its work on Sunday, reports UNB.

The commission has requested the concerned people and witnesses to send their statements, including names and addresses, to its temporary office by July 31.

It has asked the interested persons who want to give their depositions in written on the incidents to contact the commission office within the given time.

The one-member commission has been formed with Justice To-fazzal Islam of the Supreme Court to investigate July 23 incidents at the university's female dormitory.
