



4 DU students expelled for abduction link

The Dhaka University authorities on Thursday temporarily expelled four students in connection with the abduction incident at a dormitory of the university.

Masudul Alam, a second year student of Physics Department, and Ashraful Alam Azad, second year student of Statistics Department, were expelled for their direct involvement with abduction and realising ransom.

They kidnapped two youths from Mohammadpur area on July 14 and demanded Taka one lakh as ransom, hiding the youths at room no-2024 of Shahidullah Hall.

M Sabir Hasan, third year student of Physics Department and Tajul Islam, third year student to Pharmacy Department were expelled as the room the abductors used to hide the captives was allotted to them. Their allotment of the room was also cancelled.

The decision was taken at a meeting of the probe body formed to investigate into the incident.

The probe-body comprising the university Proctor and Provost of Shahidullah Hall was formed on Thursday. The committee has been asked to submit reports within three days.
