Harassment on DU female student alleged

A tense situation is prevailing on the Dhaka University campus after a female student encountered physical harassment from a teacher on Monday, reports BSS.

Angry students in the campus demanded stringent action against the teacher who earlier led female students' movement against all forms of harassment.

Sources said the teacher tried to make advances on a female student of sociology department at about 2-30 pm in his office room (number 1,079) in the Arts Building.

Some students reached the spot after the female student had screamed for help.

They told newsmen that the girl ran for safety from the office of the teacher of the history department when he invited her to accept his offer.

When contacted, the concerned teacher said, "nothing like this happened in my room and the girl is working as a research assistant".
