

## Removal of Prof Mesbah Kamal demanded

A section of Dhaka University students under the banner of "Students Against Repression" submitted a memorandum to the Vice Chancellor demanding removal of Prof Mesbah Kamal from the university.

In the memorandum, the students threatened for launching tough programmes if he was not removed from the university immediately. They also described Prof Kamal as "patron and fundraiser of anti-state elements like the indigenous people".

"The molester of a female student have no right to teach the Dhaka University students," the memorandum added.

Meanwhile, the Students Against Repression (SAR), the platform that led student outburst in late July, in a statement said a group of Islami Chhatra Shibir activists tried to use the name of the popular platform in launching false propagation against a teacher.

"The SAR that compelled the previous DU administration to resign has no link with the planned false propagation," the statement said.
