



Mysterious death of DU girl student

Rozina Mustarin (24), a final-year Bachelor's (Hons) degree student of International Relations, Dhaka University, died mysteriously at their city residence at Paribagh on Saturday morning.

Family sources claimed that she fell from the rooftop of their five-storied apartment of WAPDA Officers' Colony at about 9 am. She went on the rooftop for refreshing herself from prolonged hangover of examinations, the sources said.

The second daughter of Aziz Uddin Ahmed, Chief Engineer of Power Development Board (PDB), Rozina Mustarin used to contribute for Bangla Daily The Prothom Alo.

She was engaged with an official of Lever Brothers' Bangladesh Limited, named Kazi Zunaed Ahmed, since January 18 this year and awaiting the ceremony. Friends of the victim declined to accept this as an accident and

pointed their finger at her frustration with future planning.

Rozina's mother was in Chittagong and father in his office when the tragic incident of her death occurred. Her eldest sister Samina Mustarin is a student of Bangladesh University of Engineering and Technology (BUET).

Neighbours recovered her in a critical condition and sent her to Dhaka Medical College Hospital, where the attending doctors declared her dead.

Noted TV and film star Azaduzzaman Noor MP, actors Abul Hayat, Subarna Mustafa,

Zahid Hassan, Mou and Sami Kaiser went to her residence to condole the death.
