

DUTA to hold general meeting on law, order

A meeting of Dhaka University Teachers' Association (DUTA) on Tuesday was marred by hot altercations by rival groups, reports UNB.

Source close to the meeting said general secretary Sharif Ullah Bhuiyan called a requisition meeting, which was opposed by its President Prof Yusuf Haider saying he has no authority to call such meeting.

The four-hour meeting marked by hot exchanges ended with decision to hold a general meeting soon with an agenda for discussing law and order situation in the country.

Blue panel backed teachers tried to issue a statement on law and order situation. But the White panel, vehemently opposed the move.
