

Primary schools facing problems

GAIBANDHA, March 10: Primary schools in different Upazilas of the district have long been facing multiple problems such as accommodation shortage of furniture, lack of play ground, latrine, library and first aid arrangement.

Despite repeated appeals to the concerned authority no positive steps has been taken in this respect.

Besides most primary schools arrange no cultural function even annual sports which plays vital role in the physical and mental fitness of the students.

Although UNESCO supplied furnitures to many of the schools both in rural and urban areas that have already turned into dilapidated condition due to old age. A large number of students of rural areas even pourashava schools are attending their classes on the open floor for want of adequate benches. There is no caretaker of the schools. During night time anti-social elements assemble there for committing their ill-practices. Sometimes the miscreants took away benches window panels doors and other properties by breaking

locks. There is none to look after the interest of children. The concerned authority should be aware to arrange adequate steps to preserve the school properties deploying night guards.
