

## DU Syndicate meeting today

Dhaka University Syndicate convenes for a crucial meeting today (Saturday) to decide when to reopen the beleaguered varsity, reports UNB.

The meeting, being held amid growing pressure for resumption of classes from students and different quarters, will begin at 5:00pm at the lounge of the Administrative Building.

Earlier on August 29, the DU Syndicate in an emergency meeting had decided to resume classes on September 12 and open the dormitories on the 8th. But the dates passed by.

Former DU VC Prof Anwarul-  
lah Chowdhury closed the university sine die on July 27 following student outburst over police atrocities on female students at Shamsunnahar Hall that later led to his exit.
