

## JCD to resist conspiracy to destabilise DU

Ruling BNP's student front Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal (JCD) at a Press conference on Saturday made it clear that it would not tolerate any further demonstration on the Dhaka University campus.

The JCD leaders on Saturday said they are ready to resist "any conspiracy to destabilise the Dhaka University by the evil quarters".

On the eve of reopening the dormitories of Dhaka University, the JCD leaders blamed "an evil force from outside the campus" for deteriorating the situation in late July that led the university towards a 67-day forced closure.

In an oblique reference to opposition Awami League, Convenor of JCD's DU unit Shafiul Bari Babu said, "This identified force turned the campus volatile in a planned way, clutching the general students sentiment. They spread violence over the entire campus and compelled the authorities to close the university sine die."

Terming the Shamsunnahar Hall tragedy as painful and regrettable, the JCD leaders said they condemned the incident and demanded punishment to those

responsible for the heinous incident.

"But, the vested quarters devised deep-rooted conspiracy to gain their political interest and cheated the common students," the leaders said.

"We're for the progress of the university and none would be allowed to play bad games in the university."

Asked about any punitive measure against the JCD leaders of Shamsunnahar Hall, centering those the tragedy took place, the central JCD leader ABM Mosharraf Hossain said they were yet to get any report of the probe bodies. "The Judicial Commission just submitted the report to Home Ministry and we'll consider any punitive measure after getting the report in hand."

On peaceful coexistence of all student bodies in the dormitories, the JCD leaders said valid students would only be allowed in the dormitories.

Asked about the absence of opposition leaders in the halls, Shafiul Bari Babu said "it's the duty of the hall authorities not ours."

Earlier the DU unit JCD's convening committee held an emergency meeting and reviewed the campus situation. The committee formed eight teams vigilance on the campus yesterday to avert any untoward happenings, insiders said. The teams will also coordinate rival factions of JCD during the reopening of the dormitories.
