DU halls reopen today

All residential halls of Dhaka University will be made open for the students at 10 a.m. today (Sunday) after 63 days unscheduled closure, reports BSS.

All classes of the university will resume on October 3.

Dhaka University was closed sine die on July 28 after incidents relating to entrance of police inside a female hall (Shamsunnahar Hall).

The new Vice-Chancellor Professor S M A Faiz took charge of Dhaka University on September 23.

Provost of Shahidullah Hall Prof Abul Khair said that the provost standing committee in a recent meeting endorsed the decision to reopen DU halls to ensure a peaceful campus situation.

The committee has fixed the modalities of the re-entry of the 'valid residents' in a meeting on Friday night.

Proctor SM Atiqur Rahman told BSS that 16 boxes would be set up in 16 residential halls so that the students could submit their written complains against violation of residential rules and any hazard they encounter after return to their respective halls.
