DU classes to resume Oct 3

Classes of Dhaka University will resume on October 3, according to the latest decision by the university's highest executive body, Syndicate.

The decision to reopen the university after 67 days of 'forced closure' was taken at an emergency meeting of the DU Syndicate at the Administrative Building on Saturday.

According to the fresh schedule, the university authorities will

open the gates of the resident dormitories at 10:00 am on September 29 before resuming the classes.

Earlier on August 29, another emergency Syndicate meeting had decided to unlock the dormitories for the students on September 8 prior to holding of classes from September 12.

In its very next meeting on September 4, the Syndicate re-

versed the own decision postponing the class resumption for indefinite period. Four Syndicate members gave note of dissents against the prolonging the forced closure.

However, after reviewing the overall situation on the campus, the Saturday's Syndicate meeting finalised the date for reopening the halls as well as resuming the classes.

The process of how to arrange the reentrance of the 'valid residents' into the halls will be formulated at the next meeting.

The Vice-President of district Awami League M Alauddin had condemned the killing of Kazi Nurul Nabi and demanded immediate date.
