Khaleda hails resignation of DU V-C

Appreciating the resignation of Dhaka University Vice-Chancellor, Prime Minister Khaleda Zia on Wednesday said the government would do everything possible for the welfare of the students, says UNB.

In the backdrop of unfortunate situation prevailing for last few days on the DU campus, the Prime Minister summoned Vice-Chancellor Prof Anwarullah Chowdhury to know the overall situation.

Talking to newsmen, Prime Minister's Political Secretary Haris Chowdhury said that after a thorough discussion with the VC, the Prime Minister thought it would be prudent under the circumstances that the Vice-Chancellor should resign.
