

## DU report Commission fails to submit due to damaged computer data

The Judicial Inquiry Commission failed to submit its report to the Ministry of Home Affairs as the damaged computer data could not be recovered till Wednesday night.

The computer, in which the report was written, crashed sometime on Monday night damaging a section of the report.

The Commission, formed to probe the July 23 incidents in Shamsunnahar Hall, Dhaka University, was supposed to submit the report on Tuesday after finalising it on Monday night.

Commission Chief Justice Tafazzal Islam said some pages of the report's appendix were deleted and those need to be retyped. "It

was a mere accident," he told journalists on Wednesday and hoped after retyping the deleted pages the report would be submitted to the ministry.

Meanwhile, the delay in submitting the report triggered controversy among the concerned people. A victim of the July 23 incidents expressed her anxiety over the delay after publishing some parts of the report in newspapers.

The Commission office could not confirm when the report would be submitted.
