

31-member JCD convening committee formed BNP student front reactivated

At a crucial moment of campus politics, the ruling BNP on Monday, formed a 31-member convening committee of its student wing Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal with Shahabuddin Laitu as Convenor, reports UNB.

Prime Minister and BNP chairperson Khaleda Zia approved the new committee dissolving the suspended JCD central body, a BNP announcement said on Monday night.

She had slapped a moratorium on the central committee of her party's student front on November 17 last in the wake of tender vandalism and terrorism.

"The convening committee will hand over its responsibilities to new leaderships by December 31 after completing central conference and conferences of all the units," said a release signed by BNP Student Affairs Secretary Amanullah Aman.

Shahabuddin Laitu, general secretary of the defunct committee,

Sources in the organization told UNB that the BNP policymakers had taken initiative towards resuming the activities of JCD following the resignation of Dhaka University Vice-Chancellor amid a massive student agitation on the troubled campus.
