## Shibir opposes govt plan to ban student politics

KHULNA, Sept 25:- Islami Chhatra Shibir (ICS) has opposed government's plan of banning the students politics and still in confusion about the longevity of their relation between ICS and BNP backed Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal (JCD).

Central president of the ICS, student wing of the Jamaat-i-Islam, one major partner of the four-party government, Nurul Islam Bulbul today expressed these notions at a view exchanging meeting with journalists at Khulna Press Club this morning.

Bulbul said, we don't think that terrorism has spread much more than the past but such notion is rampant among people as most of the national dailies belong to our opposition forces. He stressed on new curriculum for educational institutions based on honesty and belief on Allah and termed former books as full of misguiding history.

ICS president said, we don't support ban of students politics rather we think those who want to ban students politics have vested interest.

Local leaders of ICS also attended the meeting.

### Life sacrificed

Another report says: A young man has sacrificed his life under the wheel of a speedy bus while saving a child from a crash this morning at district's Phultala bus stand. The brave heart man was identified as Rubel (18).

Police said, Rubel was crashed under the wheel of a Jessore bound bus at around 10/30 this morning at Phultala bus stand as he rushed to save a minor boy who was crossing the road in the face of a speedy bus. Rubel managed to save the boy but he himself went under the wheel of the bus. He died on the spot.

However police failed to identify the killer bus.

Meanwhile another young man identified as Mizanur Rahaman committed suicide last evening at city's Sonadanga area taking rectified spirit.

### PBCP man shot dead

Another report adds: One person allegedly an activist of outlaw Purbo Banglar Communist Party (PBCP) has been shot dead at city's Boyra area this evening. The killed has been identified as Mahbub Alam Tinku (28).

Police said, Tinku was fired by unidentified gunmen at around 3.30 this evening near Boyra Bazaar and he received three bullets in his body reportedly in the head and chest and died on the spot.
