



JCD president of CMC held

CHITTAGONG, Sept 28:—Police arrested the President of Chittagong Medical College (CMC) unit of Jatiatabadi Chhatra Dal (JCD) from the college campus this afternoon, (Saturday).

Panchlaish police nabbed Rashedulfinabi Biplob, a third year MBBS student and president of JCD, in front of the CMC cafeteria at about 4:00 p.m.

Police said that Biplob was an accused of eight criminal cases.

Earlier, he was caught red-handed along with three of his companions while extorting money from a shop in July this year and acquitted from the charge by a trial court early in this month.

A senior police official said that after being acquitted from charge by the court, Biplob went notorious and terrorized the CMC area again.

Removal of OC demanded
