

## NSU modifies MBA programme

NSU has revised its MBA programme from this fall semester. The programme is more global fast track, and less expensive now, said Professor Dr Hafiz GA Siddiqi, Pro Vice Chancellor of NSU in the MBA orientation programme held on Sunday, says a Press release.

He said NSU is committed to produce a large number of highly skilled professionals through providing a world class MBA programme. He indicated that the goal is to become a leading institute not only in Bangladesh but also in the whole region. He said that two separate computer labs have been set up exclusively for MBA students, equipped with latest hardware and software, not available anywhere else in the country.

Welcoming the new students Dr ANM Waheeduzzaman the Director, MBA programme, said that the MBA programme of NSU has been redesigned following the guidelines of Assembly of American Collegiate Schools of Business (AACSB). AACSB is the highest accrediting body of business schools in the USA. The number of credits has been reduced to 48. As a result it will now be possible to complete the programme normally in a year and half, and in one year with waiver. Every course has some global content in it to make the programme internationally competitive. He said faculty members must have PhD degree to teach courses in the MBA programme at NSU. It also costs significantly less than before; the programme can now be completed with Taka 2 to 2.5 lakh only, he informed the audience. Only those students who have the potential to complete the programme successfully have been admitted. NSU will provide all possible assistance for the student to realize their potentials, to complete the programme successfully and enter in the market as differentiated skilled professionals, he said.

NSU School of Business is the fastest growing business school in the country; in terms of the number of students it is already the largest business school in Bangladesh.
