

Govt for education system based on justice

Prime Minister Shah Azizur Rahman told the Jatiya Sangsad on Thursday that the Government was determined to establish an education system based on justice.

Replying to opposition criticism during their discussion on cut motions on demands for grants on the education sector in the Supplementary budget for 1978-79, Shah Aziz said that the Government needed additional funds for meeting the expenditures due to introduction of new pay scales for all

categories of teachers.

The Prime Minister, said that the Government had enhanced the pay and other allowances of teachers right from the level of primary schools to the university level.

The eleven cut motions the highest number moved on Demand Number 25 providing for additional expenditure to the tune of Taka 14 crore 55 lakh and 76 thousand. Prime Minister Shah Azizur Rahman who is in charge of education moved the demand.

Those who moved cut motions on this demand for grants were Professor Mofizul Islam (Jatiya League), Mr. Imajuddin Pramanik (AL-M), Mr. Sirajul Islam (AL-MD), Mr. Abdus Sattar Khan Chowdhury (ML), Mr. Rashed Khan Menon (Ganotantrik Andolan) and Mr. Suranjeet Sengupta (Ekots Party).
